



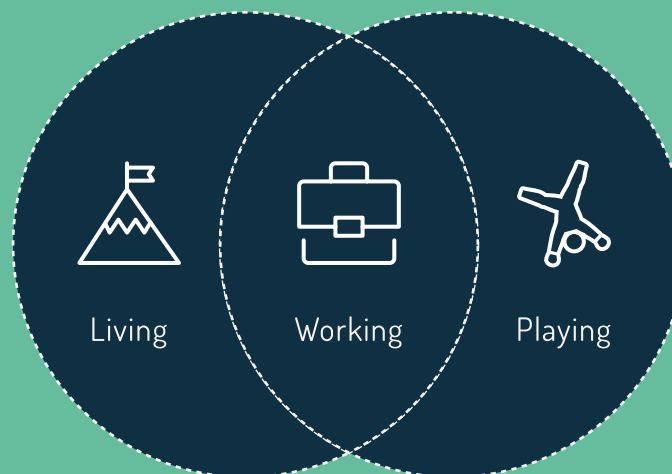

the internship:

Your work week will vary according to your schedule of school classes and English camps, around 20–30 hours total of work — including both in-classroom teaching time and preparatory/lesson planning hours. With pre-departure teacher training included, you'll be a hit from day one.



school placements:

Students range in age from primary school children to adults, and placements are at both public and private schools, camps plus English language schools.

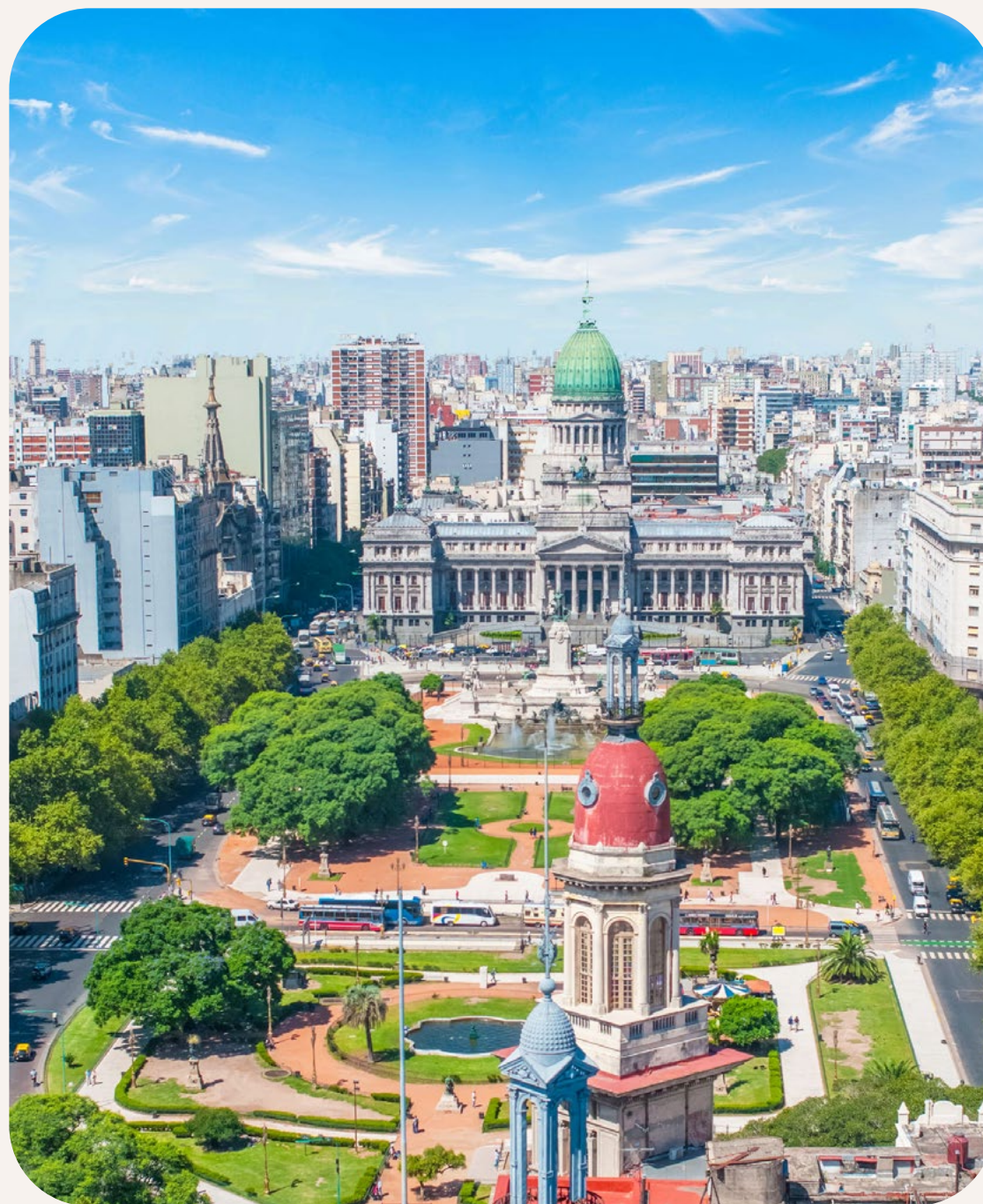

- 1 Officials in current Argentine soccer star Lionel Messi's hometown of Rosario have banned parents from naming their children "Messi" because they said it would lead to too much mass confusion.
- 2 At least one in 30 Argentines have undergone cosmetic surgery, and more than 30% have reported some form of eating disorder.
- 3 Argentines spend the most time listening to the radio, about 21 hours a week, more than any nation in the world.
- 4 Argentina is home to the giant anteater, which has a tongue that can grow up to 2 feet (60 cm) long.
- 5 Argentina's retired soccer legend Diego Maradona has his own religion made up by his fans.
- 6 Argentina is home to both the highest and lowest points of the Southern Hemisphere.
- 7 In Argentina, political parties have their own brands of beer.
- 8 In 2001, Argentina had five presidents in 10 days.



FAQ

I've already completed a TEFL course, can I get a discount?

Yes! So long as you've completed comprehensive TEFL training, you'll be eligible for a further discount. [Contact us](#) to find out how much extra you'll save.

How long before my start date should I arrive?

You should book flights to arrive into Buenos Aires Ezeiza International Airport (EZE) on your specific internship arrival day, for airport pick up and orientation.

How do I get from orientation to my placement?

At the end of your seven day Buenos Aires orientation you'll travel by public transport to your placement location and a local representative will meet you at the station or airport. Transport costs are included.

Will I be placed with other interns?

You may be the only English teacher at your school, depending which camp you take part on. There will however, be English teaching interns in towns and in cities throughout Argentina so it will be easy to make contact with fellow teachers – you'll be joining a great community of English teachers!

How much will I get paid?

Your ARS\$4,000 (US\$40/£30/€35) pocket money will be paid monthly in cash. You should budget to have enough spending money for your free time in Argentina. Since almost all other costs are covered in your internship, \$250-400 per month will give you a busy and comfortable social life. You can expect to pay around \$8 for a meal out and \$1.50 for a local beer.

TIP: Our previous interns say your first month can often be when you spend more – excursions, socialising and getting settled in. We recommend you try to budget a little extra per month for trips and then an emergency fund / credit card for unexpected events.

Who will I be teaching?

You'll be working in either public or private schools and language camps with students typically ranging from young learners to adolescents and adults.

Can I be placed with a friend?

Yes, you can request to be placed nearby a friend. You'll have a spot on your application form to mention who you're traveling with.

Note: placement in neighbouring schools and housing is dependent on availability and can't be

guaranteed (so we recommend applying early).

Where will I be located?

There are both urban and more rural placements available including: Buenos Aires, Cordoba, Rosario, Mendoza, La Plata, Tucuman, Santa Fe, San Juan, Resistencia, Neuquen, Jujuy, Corrientes, La Pampa & many more!

You will be asked to nominate your preference of placement.

(NB. due to availability preference can't be guaranteed, so it's best to apply early and be open and flexible. Our team will match you to the best placement that suits your application profile).

What will my housing be like?

Housing is provided throughout your entire stay on the internship in a homestay with a local Argentine family.

During orientation you'll share a room for the first few days with fellow interns but after that you'll typically have your own single room with a private bathroom in your family's home. On a few occasions previous interns have shared a room with a host brother or sister.

I have dietary requirements, will I manage okay?

Yes, there are both gluten & dairy free options as well as many suitable vegetarian options. Our team will be happy to assist and advise you.

What extras do I need to pay for?

- Doctor's letter (to say you're fit and well)
- Criminal record check
- Vaccines
- Comprehensive travel insurance
- Visa
- Flights

Can I book a one-way flight?

Yes, you can book a one-way flight to Argentina. We advise you to book a flexible ticket so you have the freedom to make travel plans while you're there.

It is possible (in most cases) to extend your visa duration. You'll meet other interns that you'll want to travel with afterwards and be glad of a changeable travel ticket!

Is there a chance I won't be accepted?

As with any internship your spot isn't guaranteed. Your application is subject to local school and visa approval.

If your application is not approved by our partner schools you'll be refunded all of your internship fee plus 50% of the value of your included TEFL course. Essentially, you'll get TEFL trained at half price.

We'll also guide you on other internship options or independent job searches.
