

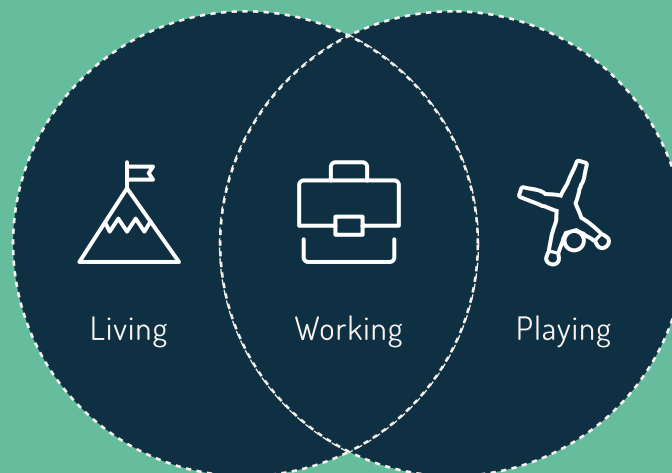

Placements & Locations

Most of the country is very rural, so you're much more likely to stumble upon quaint local villages than hordes of fellow ESL teachers.



locations:

Locations include Siem Reap, and Phnom Penh, with some placements in medium-sized towns like Battambang. Between strolls along the Mekong River and counting Wats (there are more than 2000+ of these Buddhist temples to be found!), no two days — or adventures — in Cambodia will be the same.



the internship:

You'll typically teach in class for 22-30 hours weekly, over 5-6 days. Your goal is to improve students' English reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills. Support networks are well established, and you'll have plenty of time weekly to dedicate to lesson planning and school activities.



school placements:

Teach children and teenagers at language schools, private & international schools. Class sizes usually range between 15-25 students. In most cases placement will be organized before your arrival.

Orientation & Training

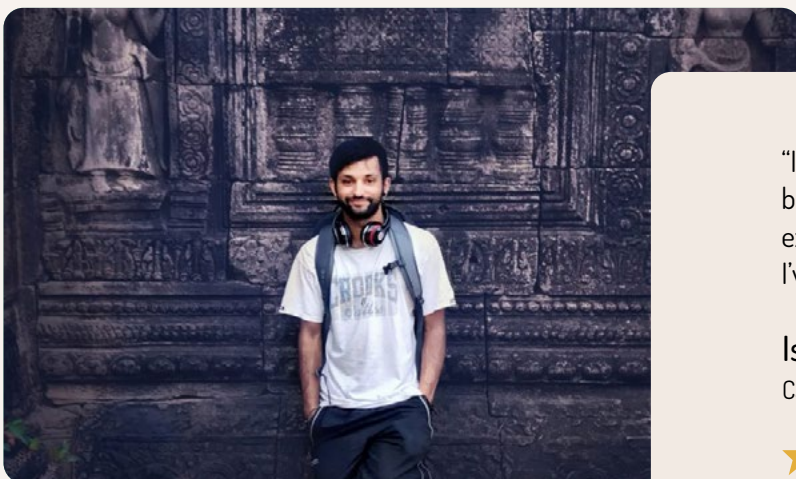

8 Cambodia Facts

- 1 In Cambodia, the head is regarded as the highest part of the body and shouldn't be touched even in the kindest manner.
- 2 Around half of Cambodia's population is younger than 15 years old. Elementary school TEFL job security, anyone?
- 3 Cambodia's New Year's celebrations (called Choul Chnam Thmey) is held in mid-April, marking the end of the harvest season.
- 4 Traditionally, birthdays are not celebrated in Cambodia. Older people usually don't even know their birthdays!
- 5 The English word Cambodia has been derived from Cambodge, the French word.
- 6 Cambodia has the largest inland lake in Southeast Asia, Tonle Sap — it's perfect for paddle boarding!
- 7 Cambodia's flag is the only one in the world to feature a building. Wat? Angkor Wat!
- 8 In Khmer, (the Cambodian language), the words for "rice" and "food" mean the same.



FAQ

I've already completed a TEFL course, can I get a discount?

Yes! So long as you've completed comprehensive TEFL training, you'll be eligible for a further discount. [Contact us](#) to find out how much extra you'll save.

How long before my start date should I arrive?

You should book flights to arrive into Phnom Penh International Airport (PNH) on your specific internship arrival day, for airport pick up and orientation.

Will I be placed with other interns?

There will be native English teachers placed in towns nearby one another. The number of interns placed in a locality depends on their size and need. You'll get to know each other during orientation so it will be easy to plan meet-ups with fellow teachers - you'll be joining a great community of English teachers!

How much will I get paid?

Cambodia offers salaries between US \$700-\$1800 and has low living expenses (average US \$500-\$700), which means you are able to fund long-term travel from your earnings and there is excellent saving potential.

TIP: Our previous interns say your first month can often be when you spend more - excursions, socialising and getting settled in. We recommend you try to budget a little extra per month for trips and then an emergency fund / credit card for unexpected events.

Who will I be teaching?

You'll be teaching children and teenagers, working at an English language school, private or International school during your 12 month placement. Most teachers work Monday - Friday.

Can I be placed with a friend?

Yes, you can request to be placed with a friend or as a couple. You'll have a spot on your application form to mention who you're traveling with.

Note: placement together is dependent on availability and can't be guaranteed.

Where will I be located?

Placements will be throughout Cambodia - including large cities such as Siem Reap, Phnom Penh with some placements in medium-sized towns like Battambang. In most cases placement will be organized before your arrival.

What will my housing be like?

There are many apartment and Khmer style houses for rent that are available for all types of spaces and budgets. We will assist you fully in finding the best place for you.

I have dietary requirements, will I manage okay?

Yes, previous interns with both gluten and dairy free requirements as well as vegetarians have managed well with advice from our in-country team.

What extras do I need to pay for?

- Health check in Cambodia worth \$15USD
- Criminal record check
- Comprehensive travel insurance
- Visa and work permit
- Flights
- Accommodation during your stay

Can I book a one-way flight?

Yes, you can book a one-way flight to Cambodia, depending on the type of visa you arrive on. We advise you to book a flexible ticket so you have the freedom to make travel plans while you're there.

During your time in Cambodia you'll meet other interns that you'll want to travel with afterwards and be glad of a changeable ticket.

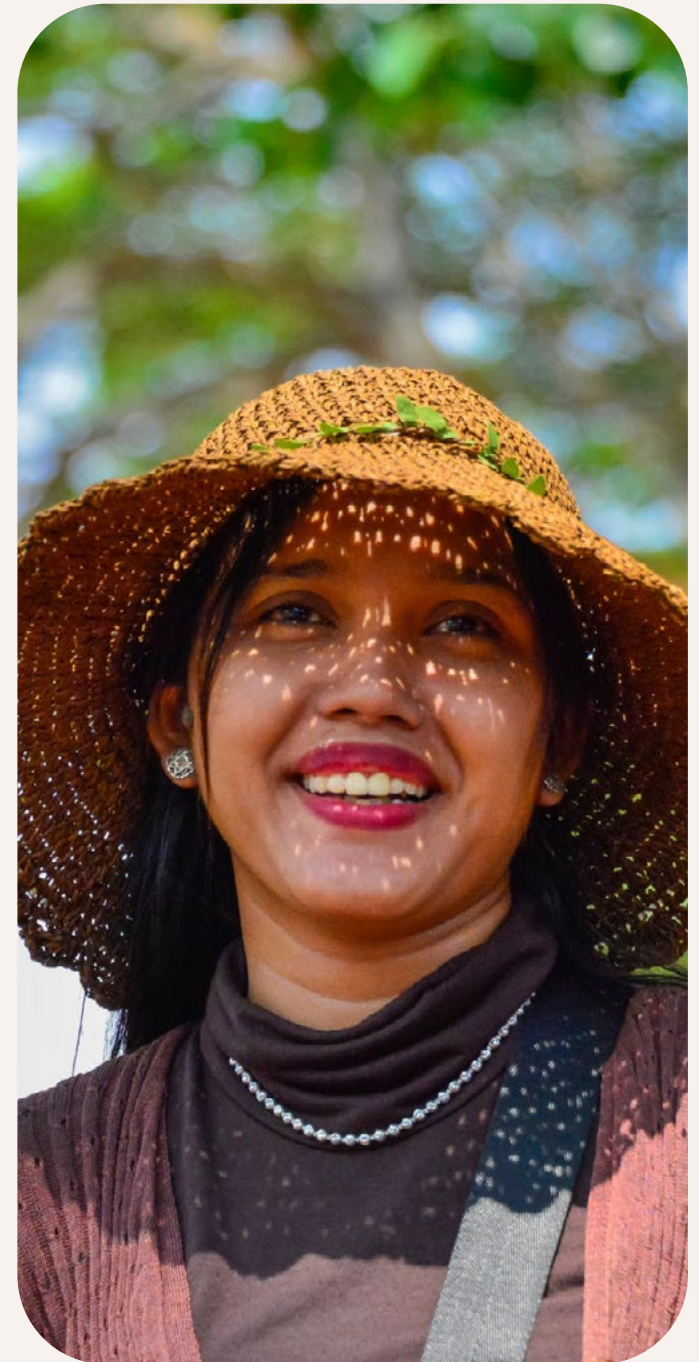

As with any internship your spot isn't guaranteed. Your application is subject to local school and visa approval.

If your application is not approved by our partner schools you'll be refunded all of your internship fee plus 50% of the value of your included TEFL course.
